



Who to Send to National Convention

1 Those Who Hold Leadership Positions

Members who are familiar with your Chapter and its practices are a good choice to send to National Convention. There are multiple opportunities to network with Members from Chapters all over the country to share ideas and experiences. Those in leadership positions should be well-informed about the desires of Chapter Members when debating and voting on changes to the National Constitution that will impact the Fraternity.

2 Those Who Want To Be Leaders

Everyone in the Chapter can be a leader, even if they do not hold a specific position. Sending a Member who aspires to be a leader in your Chapter will give them the opportunity to gain insight into the "big picture" of Phi Sigma Pi while serving in the important role of Chapter Delegate. Participating in debate and voting during Grand Chapter will provide a deeper understanding of parliamentary procedure that will serve aspiring leaders well as they take on Officer and Chair positions in the future.

3 Those Who Are New To The Chapter

Allowing new Members to attend National Convention is a great opportunity for them to get better acquainted with Phi Sigma Pi. Networking with Members from other Chapters will help them to see that there are many different ways to fundraise, recruit and run your Chapter.
